

'India, US talks for proposed trade pact going on at a very fast pace'

'FTAs that India is doing are one of the key enablers to promote GCCs'

NEW DELHI: The negotiations between India and the US for a proposed trade agreement are going at a fast pace, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said on Monday.



'Negotiations are going on at a very fast pace and in the spirit of mutual cooperation so that we can come out with a win-win trade complementing agreement with the US,' Goyal said

Meanwhile, Commerce Secretary Sunil Barthwal at a separate event said that negotiations for proposed trade agreements with the European Union (EU) and the US are going on.

He said that the free trade agreements (FTAs) that India is doing are one of the key enablers to promote global capability centres (GCCs) in the country.

"So if you look at the free trade agreements today, which we are doing with the UK, which we have just announced,

with European Union (EU), which is going on, with the US again discussions are on with several other countries in the world," Barthwal said here at CII GCC Business Summit here.

India and the US are negotiating a bilateral trade agreement (BTA). They are targeting to conclude the first phase of the pact by fall (September-October) of this year.

Similarly, India and the EU

are also negotiating a free trade agreement.

In June 2022, India and the 27-nation EU bloc resumed negotiations for a comprehensive free trade agreement, an investment protection agreement and a pact on geographical indications (GIs) after a gap of over eight years.

The talks stalled in 2013 due to differences over the level of opening up of the markets. India and the EU are targeting

Further, the secretary said that today's agreements are different from the traditional FTAs, which were confined to traditional trade, tariffs and manufacturing.

The new pacts are a more complex set of agreements which include services, a regulatory system in services, including the FDI (foreign direct investment).

Silver rises ₹5K to hit fresh peak of ₹1.15 lakh/kg

NEW DELHI: Silver prices skyrocketed Rs 5,000 to hit a fresh peak of Rs 1,15,000 per kg in the national capital on Monday as investors rushed to safe-haven assets following weakness in the US Dollar amid uncertainties over US tariff threats.

According to the All India Sarafa Association, the white metal rallied by Rs 4,500 to hit a lifetime high of Rs 1,10,000 per kilogram on Saturday.

As per the Association, gold of 99.9 per cent and 99.5 per cent purity appreciated by Rs 200 each to Rs 99,570 and Rs 99,000 per 10 grams, respectively.

Additionally, silver futures rallied by Rs 2,135 or 1.88 per cent to hit a record high of Rs 1,15,136 per kilogram on the commodities exchange. Meanwhile, the most traded gold contracts for August delivery climbed by Rs 518 or 0.53 per cent to Rs 98,336 per 10 grams on the MCX.

In the international markets, spot silver rose 1.71 per cent to \$39.02 per ounce.

Spot gold went up marginally to \$3,371.14 per ounce in the global markets.

"Gold has again resumed upside movement with prices poised to again move towards their all-time high, supported by rising tariff related uncertainty, possibility of escalation in the Russia-Ukraine war, and rising demand from ETF investors and central banks for diversification," Pranav Mer, Vice President, EBG - Commodity & Currency Research at JM Financial Services Ltd, said.

Framework issued to transfer surplus asset of 3 telecom PSUs to central entities

NEW DELHI: A high-level committee has outlined the framework for the transfer of surplus land and buildings of telecom PSUs BSNL, MTNL and ITI to central government organisations without auction.

The proposal was cleared at a meeting of Committee of Secretaries in June, which also decided that any central government organisation keen on acquiring any such property would be required to submit their interest, along with stipulated approvals and a deposit (2 per cent earnest money deposit) of the indicative value to register their claim.

This process needs to be completed within 90 days from the notification of the asset on the asset monetisation website.

Central government organisations will enjoy the right of first refusal, but after 90 days



of notification, Bharat Sanchar Nigam, Mahanagar Telephone Nigam and ITI will be free to dispose of the property to any other non-government buyer.

"As per Government policy, surplus land/building assets of PSUs of DoT are being monetised... In a recent meeting of Committee of Secretaries chaired by Cabinet Secretary on June 12, 2025, it was decided that BSNL/MTNL/ITI may transfer their immovable assets to Central Government/Central Government organisations without auction," Telecom

Secretary Neeraj Mittal said in a note circulated to secretaries of various ministries and departments.

The Department of Telecom (DoT) urged ministries to inform their departments and PSUs accordingly, noting "it has time-bound action to be initiated by them in case they wish to take their assets".

Further, the transfer of assets will be at market value fixed by specified valuation agencies or the circle rate/guideline value or ready reckoner rate, whichever is higher.

MTNL/BSNL/ITI will be valuation agencies for the value of up to Rs 10 crore, CPWD for values between Rs 10 crore and Rs 100 crore. Where the value exceeds Rs 100 crore, the National Land Monetisation Corporation will be the valuation agency.

Tata Technologies Q1 PAT up 5% at ₹170 crore

NEW DELHI: Tata Technologies Ltd (TTL) on Monday reported 5 per cent increase in consolidated profit after tax (PAT) at Rs 170.28 crore for the first quarter ended June 30, 2025 as compared to the same period last fiscal. The company had posted a PAT of Rs 162.03 crore in Q1 FY25, Tata Technologies Ltd said in a regulatory filing.

Revenue from operations in the first quarter this fiscal stood at Rs 1,244.29 crore as compared to Rs 1,268.97 crore in the year-ago period. Total expenses were higher at Rs 1,080.11 crore as compared to Rs 1,072.33 crore in the year-ago period, the global product engineering and digital services firm said.

"While the quarter began on a cautious note, client con-

fidence strengthened steadily as the period progressed, reaffirming long-term commitments to product innovation and digital transformation. This renewed belief in building the future supported strong deal momentum, resulting in six strategic wins," TTL CEO and Managing Director Warren Harris said.

Among the highlights of the quarter, TTL said Volvo Cars has selected it as a strategic supplier for product engineering, embedded software, and Product lifecycle management.

Besides, the company and Emerson have formed a strategic partnership to co-develop integrated testing and validation solutions for next-gen mobility, combining Emerson's test expertise with TTL's engineering and innovation scale.

HCLTech net profit falls 9.7% to ₹3,843 cr in Q1 FY26

NEW DELHI: HCLTech on Monday reported a 9.7 per cent decline in consolidated net profit for the April-June quarter of FY26 at Rs 3,843 crore as the IT services firm and pegged the revenue growth guidance at 3-5 per cent for FY26.

HCLTech had logged a net profit (attributable to owners of the company) of Rs 4,257 crore in the year-ago period, according to a regulatory filing.

Revenue from operations for the quarter under review was 8.1 per cent higher at Rs 30,349 crore, as against Rs 28,057 crore in Q1FY25. Seen sequentially, profit fell 10.7 per cent, while revenue was marginally up by 0.3 per cent.

Six lakh villages to get high-speed fibre-based broadband in 3 yrs: Telecom Secretary Mittal

Govt has started rolling out Bharatnet Phase 3 with an outlay of Rs 1.39L cr

NEW DELHI: As many as six lakh villages will get connected with a high-speed optical fibre-based broadband network within three years, a senior government official said on Monday.

While speaking at CII-GCC Business Summit, Telecom Secretary Neeraj Mittal said that GCCs (Global Capability Center) are currently concentrated in some of the top cities, and the wider connectivity will help them expand their footprint to tier 2 and 3 towns.

"Within three years, we will have all the village panchayats, which are roughly about 2.5

lacks, plus the villages associated with them, which are roughly about 6 lakhs, will get connected to a high-speed fibre network," he said. The government has started rolling out Bharatnet Phase 3 with an outlay of Rs 1.39 lakh crore to connect every gram panchayat and villages with an optical fibre cable (OFC) network.

The project will also connect mobile towers with OFCs that will boost network speed, as the country will look to begin high-speed 6G services in the future.

Mittal said that India has a significantly lower data cost of around 9 cents per GB com-

pared to the global average of \$2.6, which is a very significant enabler for any GCC.

"The enablers of GCC are very well established in India. We need talent, which is very critical. We need connectivity, which is excellent. The capability to innovate, the rule of law, strong IP protections, all these things make India a very attractive destination," he said.

Mittal said India's median broadband speed was about 138 Mbps.

"We cover 99.6 per cent of the GCC. There are only two districts in the country where there is no 5G. Recently, three

companies have now these new licences fully ready to commercialise, which will connect these tier 2, tier 3 cities and people who would work for these GCCs wherever they want to," he noted. The government recently freed some spectrum to boost wifi proliferation across the country. "We are working on freeing up additional spectrum and creating R&D, SMEs and startups in these fields. We hope that with all these initiatives, the GCCs will find the digital infrastructure not to be lacking when they plan for Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities," Mittal said.
